Welcome, LHSRA Wrangler Division Member!

We are so proud to have you join the LHSRA Wrangler Division! With seven qualifying rodeos, a State Finals and National Finals planned, you are in for an exciting year!

We'll start out in Ruston on October 4, so read this packet carefully and you won't miss a thing. You'll be entering just like the high school cowboys and cowgirls – through the central entry system of Rodeo Sports Network. The books are open on Monday through Wednesday; the specific times and information are enclosed. You also have an online entry option that opens every Friday at 6:00 PM.

Wrangler Division members will be eligible to compete in the Wrangler Division State Finals in any event as long as you have at least one point in that event. So, if you place in the top 10 in your event at any Wrangler Division qualifying rodeo, you'll be a State Finals Qualifier!

Central Entry System Information

Contestants will enter the week of the rodeo, in an effort to allow contestants the opportunity to have a better perspective on their weekend schedule before entering.

Late entries on Wednesdays, from 8:00 AM until 12:00 Noon, will incur a \$25.00 penalty, each time the contestant enters late. The late penalty will apply to single entries, as well as all contestants in a buddy group, team ropers whose other events were entered on time, and multiple contestant entries who call in late on Wednesday.

Call-in entry times are as follows:

Mondays – 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Tuesdays – 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Wednesdays – 9:00 AM – 12:00 Noon with penalties

Also, you do have the opportunity to enter online. User ID and password are available by calling Central Entry at 1(800) 547-6336 between the hours of 9 AM – 4 PM, Monday – Friday. I do not have access to that information.

The information on the Central Entry System (CES) is detailed. In addition, I've made you a "Quick Reference Sheet" to post in a handy place where you'll see it every week and be reminded to enter. The Call-in Menu for the entire season is enclosed. Although this shouldn't happen, if you don't show up at a rodeo or you don't pay your fees, you will have to pay the total amount for that rodeo when notified by mail or at the next rodeo.

Your back number and the bulk of your membership packet will be waiting for you when you get to Ruston or your first rodeo. You will need to show your membership card, included in this packet, to get in the rodeo at not charge (contestants only). We'll see you when you get there with other membership materials. The LHSRA Board is committed to bringing you an efficient and enjoyable rodeo season. Please let us know if we can help you in any way or answer any questions that you might have.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO CALL IN YOUR ENTRY.

How to Enter an LHSRA Rodeo

- ✓ Have your NHSRA card number (not your back number) and the Call-in Menu for the rodeo you are entering in front of you.
- ✓ Remember that this is not first come, first served (like LRCA or IPRA), so it doesn't matter when you call during call-in times.

Note: There is no limit on the number of individual contestants that one person may call to enter. That person must know the names, NHSRA numbers and the events of everyone whom he/she is entering.

YOU SHOULD BE READY TO ENTER. FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

1. Call 1-800-547-6336 (Rodeo Sports Network)
2. An operator will answer. (It will be a "real live person". This is not an automated system).
PLEASE BE AWARE THAT EVERY CALL TO RODEO SPORTS NETWORK (1-800-547-6336) IS TAPE-RECORDED. THIS IS FOR BOTH YOUR PROTECTION AND THAT OF THE COMPANY.

In some order, the following information will be gathered:

- ▶ The operator will ask for the name of the rodeo you are entering.
- ▶ The operator will ask for your NHSRA card number.
- ▶ The operator will verify your name.
- ▶ The operator will ask for the first event that you are entering.

Note: If the event is team roping or ribbon roping, the operator will ask for the name and NHSRA card number of the header/heeler and roper/runner. Your partner is then entered in team roping/ribbon roping. You may also enter him in his other events, if that is what the two of you have decided. This will eliminate double entries.

- ▶ The operator will ask for other events for that card number.
- ▶ The operator will ask if there is anyone else that the caller wishes to enter and follow the same procedure for any other contestants the caller is entering.
- ▶ The operator will give the caller a confirmation number.

3. Write down your entry confirmation number. Keep it in a handy place in case there's a discrepancy. If there is, both your confirmation number and the tape recording will be used.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- * Cowboys may only enter tie down roping or breakaway roping, not both.
- * Anyone may enter for you, if they have your NHSRA card number and name. There is no limit on the number of contestants that one person can enter.
- * Usually by Wednesday afternoon, the draw will be posted on www.lhsra.info.
- * To get results of the previous rodeo, visit www.lhsra.info.

AT THE RODEO

☆ Report to the designated area to pay your fees. Please understand that your fees should be paid before you ride, but there is no requirement to arrive at a certain time. Fees may be paid in cash or by check. (Money orders are accepted, but they are not required!) NSF checks will include a \$20.00 charge. Please try to have the right amount of money, if you are paying in cash!

DRAW-OUTS

If you call in on the Thursday of the week of the rodeo, no reasons are needed to draw out of one or more events or the entire rodeo and you are not responsible for fees. After THURSDAY at 4:00 PM, you will be billed for entry fees if you draw out or turn out (no show). There are no reasons to excuse you from fees after 4:00 PM on Thursday. After that time, the fees are guaranteed to the qualifying rodeo. So, there is no need to produce a doctor's or vet's excuse or other document. They will not be accepted.
