

CALL IN Procedure to enter LHSRA Rodeos

- ❖ Have your NHSRA membership card number and the preference menu available. The preference menu will indicate the dates and times to call in for a specific rodeo.
- ❖ Before calling
 - know which performance or slack you are going to request.
 - If you are “buddying” with another contestant(s)
 - If you are entering the optional jackpot (applies to High School only)
- ❖ Call Rodeo Sports Network – a real person will answer. Follow her prompts and provide all necessary information. She will review this entry information with you and issue a confirmation number.
- ❖ **Write down** your confirmation number. Also, ALL conversations are recorded as documentation for you as well as RSN. If there is a problem with your entry both the confirmation number and recording will be used to verify your entry.
- ❖ The draw will be posted late Wednesday afternoon on www.rodeosportsnetwork.com and also on www.lhsra.info
- ❖ Once the draw is posted, check it carefully. If you feel there is a problem, you may call RSN to follow up within office hours. Have your confirmation number available. Office hours are Monday – Friday 9am to 4pm. (these are not call in hours)

General Information

Preferences

- ✚ At this point, for all Junior High and High School Rodeos held the same weekend, preferences (choice) of performance or slack will be granted. This will also apply to the double week-end rodeos. Preferences are per event and may be split up if you like.
- ✚ The remaining single HS Rodeos will require a first and second preference.

Buddying

- ✚ The buddying system is set up to allow up to 4 people to be in a buddy group. This is especially important to team ropers and ribbon ropers.
- ✚ At the single week-end HS rodeos where a 1st and 2nd preference will be needed, please be aware that if you are "buddied" with someone and your buddy does not get their first preference, everyone in the buddy group will be moved.
- ✚ The person calling in a buddy group must have the names, NHSRA numbers, and events of everyone in the buddy group (no more than 4).

Entry Fees for Junior High

- ✚ There is a onetime per rodeo "rodeo fee" of \$17 plus a \$25 per event entry fee. If entering one event the fees will be \$42; if two events-\$67, three events-\$92 and so on.
- ✚ Please pay your fees at the rodeo, BEFORE you ride. Cash and personal checks are accepted for entry fees. There is a \$25 charge for NSF checks.

Entry Fees for High School

- ✚ There is a onetime per rodeo "rodeo fee" of \$17 plus \$15 per event entry fee, except for cutting. Cutting entry fees are \$50. If entering one event, the fees will be \$32; two events- \$47; three events- \$62 and so on. If cutting is the only event, fees would be \$67.
- ✚ If entering the OPTIONAL JACKPOT simply add \$15 on top of the basic entry fee in each event that you have chosen to jackpot!
- ✚ Please pay your fees at the rodeo BEFORE you ride. Cash and personal checks are accepted for entry fees. There is a \$25 charge for NSF checks.

Optional Jackpot (applies only to High School)

- ✚ Upon entering an event high school contestants have an option to jackpot any one or all of the events they enter.
- ✚ There is an additional \$15 fee and the hosting rodeo adds \$100 per event to the pot. Payout is based on the number of contestants in the jackpot.
- ✚ This does not apply to Junior High contestants as all JH contestants are in the jackpot.
